<u>Residency</u> Programme

For art curators from Kosovo



The programme

The Centre culturel du Kosovo à Paris and the Cité internationale des arts offer a residency in Paris from January 4th to March 27th, 2024. This call is open for **professionals, researchers/theorists linked to the field of museology, museography and curatorship of exhibitions**.

The call concerns professionals and **researchers of Kosovan nationality residing in Kosovo**. They must be familiar with either French or English language.

This program is supported by The Embassy of Kosovo in Paris and the Embassy of France in Prishtina..

The residency

The programme includes :

- Networking opportunities within a community of 325 other artists in residence from various disciplines, of different ages and nationalities, as well as depending on the project with professionals.
- A live-in-studio on the Marais site of the Cité internationale des arts from January 04, 2024 to March 28, 2024
- A living allowance may be awarded depending on the laureate's resources

It is possible for the resident to be accompanied by an adult and/or a child under 7 years old. Animals are not allowed.

The resident will be subject to the rules and regulations of the Cité internationale des arts.

The laureate is responsible for the following costs:

- Transport from Prishtina / Paris and return
- Personal insurance covering sickness, repatriation and civil liability
- Other expenses (trips, visits...)

Prior to arrival

The future resident is invited to take French lessons prior to his/her departure for Paris and then during his/her stay at the Cité internationale des arts to facilitate his/her integration.

Before his/her departure, the future resident shall contact the Cité internationale des arts' management to present his/her artistic project and benefit from a personalized support. Upon his/her arrival in Paris, he/ she shall call for an appointment with the Cité internationale des arts' management team.



The artist's involvement in the community

The Cité internationale des arts is a transdisciplinary, transnational and transgenerational community.

Residents take part in the life of a community of over 300 artists-inresidence each of whom contributes to its cultural dynamism.

Regular events are organised by the Cité to bring residents together. The cultural programming department organises exhibitions, concerts, get-togethers, readings, screenings, performances and Open Studios and is open to suggestions for other types of events.

Developed with and for residents no matter what stage their project is at, the events programme provides residents with an opportunity to share their work with a variety of audiences.

The events programme is devised by Cité internationale des arts team and each event is the subject of exchanges with the artists and curators in charge of the project.

Selection

The laureate will be selected by a jury that comprises the Cité internationale des arts.

For this selection, the jury will take into account:

- the candidate's professional background,
- the content and quality of the project,
- he content of his/her research project during the residency, as well as his/her motivation,
- is/her ability to benefit from the artistic environment offered by the Cité.

The results will be disclosed by e-mail to the candidates in early-Novembre 2023.

The Cité internationale des arts

The Cité internationale des arts is a residency centre that brings artists and culture professionals together in the heart of Paris, allowing them to work on creative projects or carry out research project in all disciplines.

The Cité internationale des arts provides an environment that is conducive to creativity by hosting residents for periods of two months to one year and facilitating contacts with arts and culture professionals.

Residents receive personalised support and assistance from the Cité internationale des arts team at its two sites: in the Marais (18 rue de l'Hôtel de Ville, 75004 Paris) and Montmartre (24 rue Norvins, 75018 Paris). Each residency is an opportunity to meet and exchange with more than 300 artists and culture professionals of all generations, nationalities and disciplines.

In collaboration with its many partners, the Cité internationale des arts calls for applications on specific themes and/or projects several times a year.
